Last Moon

This past moon ("mun"-means month in Tok Pisin) we moved to our new "permanent" residence here in PNG. The Sepik region is where God is currently leading us, and there are several tribes in this area alone asking for a missionary to come and give them God's talk. We learned that there is a filing cabinet full of letters from the various tribes who are asking for the Gospel (we will post a blog about that later). A drawer dedicated to the many asking to know who God is, and yet there are not enough laborers to accomplish this task. We went through orientation and helped/are helping in various ministries, we finally feel a little more settled and started our second week of language learning here this week, we have been out of a groove for a month because of all the transitions.

This Moon

We have a desire to "complete" the next milestone in language learning this month, if you could put a language on a scale from 1-12; 12 meaning you are in the proficient range. After mark 9, you are at a place where you can teach in the language properly, we are both at mark 8, so close to the finish line!

The Two Moons to Follow

At the end July, we will go to "bush orientation" on an island called Biem. We will be there for 4-8 weeks, perfecting our Tok Pisin and

learning the process of cross-cultural church planting. The Biem church is currently at a place where the indigenous people are teaching their own people for the first time. So exciting, **please** pray for them!
