This time has been a season of sifting for us, really praying and seeking God, desiring to grow and serve Him more whole-heartedly. Our once vacant base has grown to almost full capacity, several teams coming back from furlough to go back to their work, several new families, and much more coming and going here in Wewak. With all these new families we began the process of helping them transition, as well as training people to do various jobs around the base and get involved in the bush ministries.

With this time of actually having people to help with the various jobs around the base, we saw it fitting that God would direct us and enable us to go to the bush! As you all know, that is our heart, and where God keeps directing us, we long for the day to see where God will lead us full-time... and that day might come soon. While we wait upon the Lord, we are serving another tribal missionary.

Unlike our previous trips where we went to "finished/phased out works" and help encourage the church, spurring them on to keep the faith, this trip is diametrically different. With our very limited Indonesian, and for the most part less than a handful of people in this tribe even speak Indonesian, we have learned a few phrases and words in their heart language. Seth has learned some words and phrases in the Dem language from the men that help him work on projects around the house, and Nicole has picked up some language as well as she spends time with the ladies. She has been able to be with several

ladies just hours and even minutes before they had their babies!

Once again, every time we are in the bush being with the people, spending time with them, we are reminded this type of work is what God has put in our hearts to do.
