Being so isolated, not being able to readily access the outside world, tribal missionaries quickly become the go-to person for an array of things. They help with medical and medevacs, pregnancies, government liaison work, flight coordinating, maintenance, care-taker of the airstrip, community talks and relations, and ordering supplies. You can have someone call out your name from outside of you house before the sunlight comes up

asking for your help with a complication in a pregnancy, or you can get

the midnight request for coffee... life in the bush never has an "off"

Seth helped out with projects every day, and at a moments notice the water would go out and Seth would have to hike up the hill to fix the blockage in the tank from the stream, or a pig would break through the fence and start tearing up the airstrip and Seth would have to go chase off the pig; fix the fence, and repair the damage done us and grown us in so many ways. We see Him to the airstrip. We helped out with the kids, food, cleaning, schooling and every day life that is complicated by tribal living. With all that being said we pray that as your sent-ones, we were able to encourage them, help out in any way possible, propel them to press on, and that God uses this time to remind them they are loved, and not allow the devil to discourage them and any little whisper he might try to put in their head to not finish.
