Growth both foreign and domestic:

Nearly every week we try to "get ahold of" our Tiale family through various means. Over the past month or so we have received many reports of their faithfulness to God. Our men are being faithful to their congregations and the women have been continuing to lead the Bible studies we left for them. The men even go to our local town to lead conference(s) and be encouragements to other people, showing their growth from once being fed to now feeding others with God's Word. They were asked "how do you know Gods Word so well?", they replied with smiles saying, "we are taught like students are in a university in the USA". At another event, a local leader asked them "where did you get these teachings?", and they replied, "our missionary taught us all of this". More recently another event was held, and the teacher shared some points on a topic, the three men looked at each other and told the teacher "we have have had these teachings for years, and in a more full context". Time and time again these men are seeing they are being well equipped.

The ladies continue to be faithful to the Bible studies, and one of the young women saw the need to start another group. God has been very gracious and we are thankful to see these women take ownership of maturing other ladies in the faith.

One of the most recent moments of joy is that one of the local pastors was able to lead the witchdoctors son to the Lord! In this particular village the witchdoctor rules with supreme fear, and now his son is a follower of Jesus, rebuking the teachings of his father to his face.

Domestic:

"How is my granddaughter doing?" One of Seth's village "dads" called and asked how Nicole is doing, along with how his grand-baby is doing. The Tiale people are excited to see their village grow (yes, they view our daughter as part of their village). We love seeing how excited and how invested they are in Nicole's pregnancy, and they all argue who will hold her more than others, as typical grandparents would.

We have been speaking at several new churches these past couple of weeks, raising both awareness of missions for Unreached People Groups, as well as growing our ministry partnership team. With the addition of a new member, along with various other adjustments to our budget as we talked with our home church, we realized we are at approximately 89% of
